1. Go to [www.google.com](http://www.google.com).

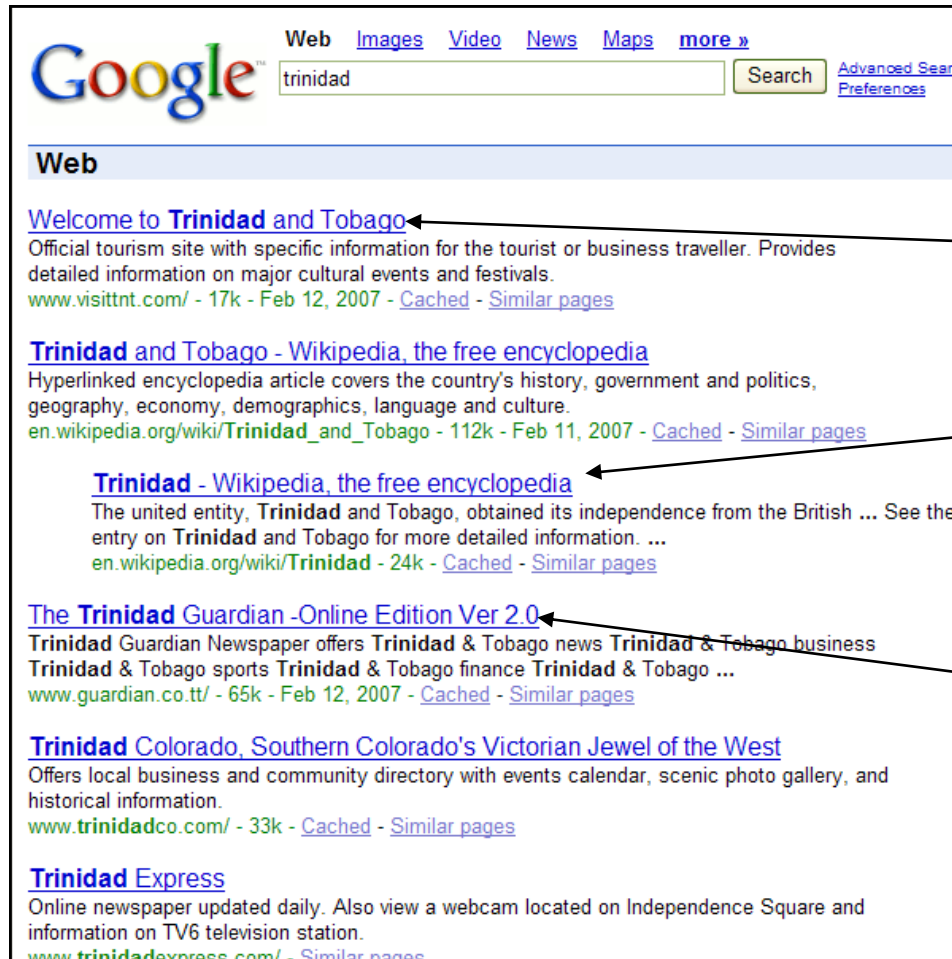
Research the place you want to go.
